6:35 MCAS Vacant Positions

- Director
 - Position not yet filled, recruitment active and being done through outside national recruiting agency.

• Animal Care and Client Services Ops Supervisors

- Stacy Thurman and Amy Bobish no longer with us. Jennifer Sparkman is filling in for Animal Care, and Tina Hodge for Client Services.
- Both positions are anticipated to be filled permanently by the end of November.

• Veterinarian and CVT -

- Interviews are scheduled for the end of this month and the position should be filled by the end of November.
- o CVT Position has been filled and will start by the end of this month
- **OA2-** Two vacancies to fill and recruitments are active now.
- ACO2 and Dispatcher -
 - New ACO2 just started a few weeks ago.
